


	00:42	Although we're near the equator of Mars, it's always cold compared with Earth. So we travel to the canyon rim in a warm pressurized rover. The sky is beautiful here, but we can't breathe the planet's thin carbon dioxide atmosphere.
	01:00	Scientists back at our outpost, monitor our video and the conditions inside our pressurized rover.
	01:08	It's possible that water once flowed in the Valles Marineris, much like the Colorado River flows through the Grand Canyon on the Earth today. Rappelling into Earth's Grand Canyon cannot compare to this off-world adventure, where we weigh much less and our canyon is over 4 times deeper.
