	00:12	Welcome to the perpetual twilight of Shackleton Crater. The Sun peeks above the crater rim and circles the horizon each month.
	00:21	Our monster truck is much more like a modern Earth truck than the Apollo rover. The steep torturous terrain of Shackleton Crater requires a much tougher vehicle. Those crater walls drop over 4 kilometers to the cold crater floor.
	00:41	Eighty people live in our lunar colony, built with tubes and inflatable rings transported from Earth.
	00:48	Robotic ice miners like this descend all the way to the crater floor. We melt the ice they collect for water to drink and separate it into oxygen and hydrogen for rocket fuel.
	01:02	Our greatest gravity thrill is driving a monster truck along these steep crater walls – slipping and sliding in the lunar dust, while trying not to tumble into the crater. No steep mountain road on Earth can compare with this breathtaking low-g experience.
